
TO THE MOTHER CITY OF CAPE TOWN...



In November 2010, after I returned from South Korea, God withdrew me from public view for a short season of preparation. Being in the Prophetic Ministry, I have become quite used to being removed from the scene from time to time and I have learnt that this is the way in which God deals with me, to prepare me for specific assignments. During this time, God clearly told me that He would release and send me to cities and nations with a very particular mandate and commission. The times during which He withdraws me from sight, are spent in His Presence, under His guidance, being imparted by His grace and instructed by His Spirit for the task at hand...

Cape Town, God has earmarked you for greater things to come...

An invitation came for me to minister during March 2011 in Cape Town, South Africa and God confirmed the assignment to the city.

I arrived in Cape Town on Saturday the 12th of March to start a series of prophetic meetings the following day. On Monday morning, the 14th of March 2011, as I was seeking God's heart I had an awesome visitation from Him as He began to share His heart with me for the city. At first, He dropped one phrase into my heart as He said to me: "Mother City". As God spoke this phrase, heaven began to open and I suddenly became aware of a great presence of angelic activities in the atmosphere over the city. I saw seasons change, champions released and strongholds come tumbling down...

This session opened up a tremendous time of great impartation for all who came to the meetings during that week. It also set up my schedule with God for the rest of the week, as He came to wake me each morning around 4 am, to discuss with me the future of the City of Cape Town. My mandate was simple, clear and precise: "To raise champions..."

On Monday evening, the 14th of March 2011, I released a prophetic message over the City of Cape Town as God gave it to me during the day. This word comes from the heart of God and is based on 2nd Samuel 20:1 – 22.

- 1 And there happened to be there a man of Belial named Sheba, the son of Bichri, a Benjamite. And he blew a ram's horn and said, We have no part in David, neither do we have any inheritance in the son of Jesse. Every man to his tents, O, Israel!
- 2 And every man of Israel went up from after David, following Sheba the son of Bichri. But the men of Judah clung to their king, from Jordan even to Jerusalem.
- 3 And David came to his house at Jerusalem. And the king took the ten women, *his* concubines, whom he had left to keep the house, and put them in ward, and fed them but did not go in to them. And they were shut up till the day of their death, living in widowhood.
- 4 And the king said to Amasa, gather to me the men of Judah *within* three days, and you be present here.
- 5 And Amasa went to gather Judah. But he stayed longer than the set time which he had appointed him.
- 6 And David said to Abishai, And Sheba the son of Bichri shall do us more harm than Absalom. You take your lord's servants and pursue him, lest he get himself into fortified cities and escape us.
- 7 And Joab's men went out after him, and the Cherethites, and the Pelethites, and all the mighty men. And they went out of Jerusalem to pursue Sheba the son of Bichri.
- 8 They *were* at the great stone which *is* in Gibeon, and Amasa had gone before them. And Joab was girded *with* his war-coat as his clothing. And upon it was a girdle with a sword fastened upon his loins, in its sheath. And as he went forth, it fell out.
- 9 And Joab said to Amasa, *Are* you well, my brother? And Joab took Amasa by the beard with the right hand to kiss him.
- 10 And Amasa was not on guard against the sword that *was* in Joab's hand. And he struck him with it in the belly, and poured out his bowels to the ground. And *he* did not strike him again. And he died. And Joab and Abishai his brother pursued after Sheba the son of Bichri.
- 11 And one of Joab's men stood by him and said, He who favors Joab, and he who *is* for David, *go* after Joab!
- 12 And Amasa wallowed in blood in the middle of the highway. And the man saw that all the people stood still. And he moved Amasa out of the highway into the field, and threw a garment over him when he saw that everyone who came by him stood still.
- 13 When he was moved out of the highway, all the people went on after Joab, to pursue after Sheba the son of Bichri.
- 14 And he went through all the tribes of Israel to Abel, and to Beth-maachah, and to all the Berites. And they were gathered, and went after him too.

- 15 And they came and besieged him in Abel of Beth-maachah. And they threw up a siege-mound against the city. And it stood against the wall. And all the people with Joab were undermining the wall to make it fall.
- 16 Then a wise woman cried out of the city, Hear, hear! Please say to Joab, Come near here so that I may speak with you.
- 17 And when he had come near her, the woman said, *Are* you Joab? And he answered, I *am*. And she said to him; Hear the words of your handmaid. And he answered, I hear.
- 18 And she spoke, saying, They spoke often in days gone by, saying, Surely they will ask of Abel, and so they ended *the matter*.
- 19 I *am* peaceable *and* faithful in Israel. You seek to destroy a city and a mother in Israel. Why will you swallow up the inheritance of Jehovah?
- 20 And Joab answered and said, Far be it, far be it from me, that I should swallow up or destroy.
- 21 The matter *is* not so. But a man of Mount Ephraim, Sheba the son of Bichri by name, has lifted up his hand against the king, against David. Only deliver him, and I will depart from the city. And the woman said to Joab, Behold, his head shall be thrown to you over the wall.
- 22 Then the woman went to all the people in her wisdom. And they cut off the head of Sheba the son of Bichri, and threw *it* out to Joab. And he blew the ram's horn, and they scattered from the city, each man to his tent. And Joab returned to Jerusalem to the king.

Explanation of Prophetic Symbols:

- Man of Belial – Someone without value, worthless, no profit to others, bringing along destruction through evil deeds and actions.
- Sheba – Seven, fullness, number of God's completeness and readiness for godly impact to bring divine dominance and worldwide impact.
- Bichri – Youthful, to burst the womb, make or bring early fruit, to give the birth right, produce new fruit
- Benjamite – Son of the right hand
- Blow the trumpet – to make a clear sound, take a definite stance, gather people for religious move or war which will have great impact
- Every man to his tents – sign of rebellion to influence people to change position
- Wise woman – the Bride of Jesus Christ, City Church with Community vision,
- City – Place of protection, safe haven for families, individuals, unity, economical hub, resting place, place of order, opportunities, clear boundaries, constantly watched over, privileged access by association only, place of authority, strong, elevated
- Mother City – a City acknowledged for bringing forth fruit, plans, direction, opportunities, proposals, systems, leadership, etc. to it's country, surroundings and nation. A place of great influence, impact in the natural and spiritual realms. Like a true mother, she is the bond of a nation, bringing unity, nourishment, education and the feeling of "belonging".

Introduction to the word:

The key to this whole word, is found in verse 19 where the city to which this son of Belial, or rebel fled to, is described as follows in the various translations:

2Sa 20:19

(ABP+) I^{G1473} am^{G1510.2.1} peaceable^{G1516} of ones supporting^{G4739.6} Israel.^{G} But you^{G1473 G1161} seek^{G2212} to kill^{G2289} a city,^{G4172} even^{G2532} a mother-city^{G3390} in^{G1722} Israel.^{G*} Why^{G2444} do you swallow down^{G2666} the inheritance^{G2817} of the LORD?^{G2962}*

(AOV) Ek is een van die vredeliewendes, van die getroues in Israel. U is daarop uit om 'n stad te vernietig, nogal 'n moeder in Israel. Waarom wil u die erfdeel van die HERE te gronde rig?

(ASV) I am of them that are peaceable and faithful in Israel: thou seekest to destroy a city and a mother in Israel: why wilt thou swallow up the inheritance of Jehovah?

(CEV) We are Israelites, and we want peace! You can trust us. Why are you trying to destroy a town that's like a mother in Israel? Why do you want to wipe out the LORD's people?"

(GW) We are peaceful and faithful Israelites. Are you trying to destroy a mother city in Israel? Why should you swallow up what belongs to the LORD?"

(KJV) I am one of them that are peaceable and faithful in Israel: thou seekest to destroy a city and a mother in Israel: why wilt thou swallow up the inheritance of the LORD?

(KJV+) I^{H595} am one of them that are peaceable^{H7999} and faithful^{H539} in Israel:^{H3478} thou^{H859} seekest^{H1245} to destroy^{H4191} a city^{H5892} and a mother^{H517} in Israel:^{H3478} why^{H4100} wilt thou swallow up^{H1104} the inheritance^{H5159} of the LORD?^{H3068}

(LITV) I am of the peaceful, faithful ones of Israel. You are seeking to destroy a city, and a mother in Israel. Why will you swallow up the inheritance of Jehovah?

(MKJV) I am peaceable and faithful in Israel. You seek to destroy a city and a mother in Israel. Why will you swallow up the inheritance of Jehovah?

Take note that as I was praying while in Cape Town, God clearly spoke to me about Cape Town as the Mother City of South Africa. At first, He dropped the phrase into my heart and then began to literally flood me with His excitement over the true meaning of the phrase as it applies to Cape Town! He then led me to this passage of scripture and began to download a prophetic message into my spirit to be released as His timeous word over the city.

Apparently, someone else prophesied about two weeks before my visit to the City, that God would send someone, to release an accurate prophetic word over the City, soon...

Someone else apparently had a dream about this very same word that was released that night on the 14th of March 2011.

I can therefore say and confirm, Cape Town, thus says the Lord God Almighty...

As this rebel, a worthless, unprofitable son, rose up in rebellion against King David, so the spirit of the anti-Christ or the destroyer of humankind, rises up against God's plans, purposes and destiny for individuals, families, communities, cities and nations. Nothing belongs to this thief and so he always latches unto opportunities and platforms from where God wants to launch out in His fullness, by using us, His created vessels.

Take note that although this rebel was known as a rebel and a worthless person, by his actions, his origin is found in the Image and Likeness of His Creator, God Himself. His name, Sheba, speaks of so much of God in Him, it speaks of having the potential to be a person of international influence and impact, but wrong choices, past experiences and failed opportunities, opened him up to be used by outside influences. This person lost his true identity, and through this, wanted to become famous for exactly the opposite than for what he was created for. Through his reputation, he gained a position of influence and support. How many of us, through our past hurts, disappointments, failures and wrong choices, carry influence, but a negative kind. We have all the potential to cause an absolute riot for God and His Kingdom, but our lack of love and support for His cause, makes us work against Him. This is what religion does, it is no different from rebellion, mutiny, selfish ambition, and can be seen in the same light as terrorism, gangsterism and criminal activities against the Creator of mankind. The father of this rebellious son, was known to bring forth excellent, fresh fruit, something new, accurate and life changing.

Coming from the tribe of Benjamin, gave this son further inherited qualities as the Benjamites were known for their loyalty, perseverance, bravery, skilled in warfare, prophetic ability and their passion and zeal to fulfil an assignment, to name but a few.

When God created you, His greatest dream for you, was to burst you onto the scene, called earth, as a fresh, new season! The birth of every new-born baby is an announcement from heaven, that God is up to something brand new! He is about to spoil creation with a fresh move and a touch from Him! He also knows that sin will "contaminate his move", for a while, only until He touches them again through the message of the Gospel, reconnecting them as His original purpose to change the earth...

Cape Town, you are covered with such new moves of God, each one of you were strategically placed within the womb of the mother of cities with a clear mandate: "Be a champion to the nation of South Africa".

Imagine how this son, with so much potential, began to pour himself into the wrong actions. He lost track and sight of his real reason for being alive, supporting the chosen king and building only one kingdom! God showed me my very first mandate towards Cape Town:

- To show people their true worth, deliver them from their past and realign them with their redemptive purpose, so that Champions for Christ will arise...
- Cape Town is the natural birth place for those with the supernatural ability to change the destiny and future of South Africa, Africa and the nations of the world.
- This process is very crucial to the rest of South Africa's future and destiny.

This rebellious son, had great zeal, passion and skills to draw an entire nation to follow him and his desires. With these skills and potential, when King David discovered this man's motives, he decided to act swiftly to stop him from gaining enough support, to influence the entire nation. Much can be said about the people David chose and the process in dealing with the threat against his kingdom and throne, but what God showed me and is applicable on the City of Cape Town, is the place of choice the rebel ran to. He chose to seek refuge in a City, known as a mother city in the nation. To him it was an obvious choice as he needed a platform of importance to launch him from, in the future. This city was known for her ability to bring forth fruit for the nation in the spiritual realm. She was the most perfect place to plant the seed of rebellion in, so that it could be established as a future harvest.

He knew that he could determine the next generation's attitude and support towards God and God's choice for a king, if he could settle in a city, known as the mother of the nation. This rebel could have settled in any other city, but he ran for the launching pad of future spiritual attacks on the nation. Cape Town, you are the mother City of South Africa! You gave birth to the cities and towns in South Africa! You were first to be released onto the soil of Southern Africa as God's launching pad into the area. From your midst came forth the pioneers who raised other cities, towns and communities from the dust of the African soil. Your pioneers came with a clear mandate from God, to bring Christ to the continent. To spread the good news about the only Kingdom that matters. Your voice is meant to bring direction, set up clear boundaries, release directives, create peaceful solutions, raise the standard of living, educate and school the young, next generation, give birth to radical, pioneers. You are to be the roots of the country, feeding true nourishment into the rest of the tree, called South Africa. The nourishment you provide, determines the quality of the fruit displayed on this tree, which should be food to the nations! When a mother is absent, the house gets neglected. Mealtimes become unimportant, schooling loses its value, relationships become superficial and children feel unloved and unwanted. Time schedules disappear and healthy routine, necessary for growth towards maturity and responsibility, is abandoned.

Jesus told His disciples that the thief comes to steal, to kill and to destroy (John 10:10).

First, he breaks in to see what he can carry off. As he breaks in, he assesses the alertness of the house he entered. He starts by taking seemingly insignificant items to determine the watchfulness of the house. He may move some items around, shuffle the routine, turn the clock back, to test the house. His first priority is to establish how much room he has to work with. This includes the breaking of godly habits, discipline, family-time and other things we take for granted in our homes. He moves in so subtly, if we are not careful, he will steal from our midst in such a way, that the damage only becomes evident when it is almost too late to repair.

He is the rebel, the worthless, unprofitable one who sneaks in, to see how long he can hang around without being discovered. As we allow him to linger in our midst, he begins to shift our sense of godliness, holiness and purity. Once he settles, he launches the second phase, killing our sensitivity towards God's presence, our love for godly living and our true reason for living! This affects our entire existence at all levels, not only towards God, but even those around us, including our surroundings. He finds a foothold in us, in our homes, and then begin to rearrange our communities and cities, eventually leading to our own destruction, of our loved ones and then our cities.

This rebel, in David's time, knew he would first have to steal a small space in that city to operate from. His presence and the inhabitant's lack of throwing him out, would eventually result in him becoming an alternative way of living. He would gradually offer an alternative lifestyle to those who watched him, and the fact that the community didn't resist him in their midst, would mean his way of living, was also acceptable. At first, his lifestyle will revolt some of the community, but their lack of action will cause a generation to be born, who doesn't find it revolting, but acceptable. You see, these rebels are very patient, they always have the future in mind. They know that the very first step towards their goal is to steal something that does not belong to them. If no one notices, they settle in, and slowly but surely begin to kill their environment so that they can reshape it or bluntly put, destroy it for achieving God's purposes!

Eventually a generation is born without any identification, or destiny. A generation is brought forth without any godly mandate or direction. Boundaries disappear, communication is lost, and truth is replaced with relativism. This means that truth is what you perceive it to be and your actions are justified by your circumstances and any choice of lifestyle is acceptable as long as your intentions are generally good.

There are numerous rebellious spirits living in the midst of our homes, hearts, communities and cities. They have been living there for centuries and gradually moved from stealing, to killing which resulted in destruction. We are no longer aware of the fact that they have no right of admission, left alone residency in our areas! Remember how Paul said in the letter to the Church at Ephesus, *"for we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against*

the world's rulers, of the darkness of this age, against spiritual wickedness in high places.”

These agents of death and destruction operate through flesh and blood, because they need a vehicle to move around in and to do their filthy work! They are found in concentrated numbers where flesh and blood dwells...

In order to find out the redemptive purpose of a community, or a city or a nation, one has to look at the negative side of things. The spirit realm normally reflects itself through the actions of human beings and negative actions and incidents is the exact opposite of God's destiny and purpose for that community. These demonic forces aim straight for the true heart of something and turn it the other way around. A City earmarked by God to be out of the ordinary servants to the nation, will be flooded by the enemy to release pride and arrogance and intolerance towards one another.

Racism will be evident and vast cultural and social differences will be rife amongst the inhabitants.

In a mother City, some of the following characteristics will be evident:

- Because of her natural, supernatural purpose to give birth to Godly destiny, abortions will be general practise. Child abandonment will be high, sexual intercourse will be a cheap commodity as its true meaning will be tarnished. Family life will be attacked with many broken homes and instability. Street children will be abundant, foster homes flooded and orphanages numerous, but without real support and strong educational direction. Marriages will be under pressure, abortions frequent and gay and lesbian rights strongly advocated. Children are always preyed on and often murdered or hurt.
- Generations will be brought forth with no real sense of identity, no sense of godly purpose and young people will frequently fall into habitual addictions of substance abuse. Suicides amongst the young will be high, and the outcasts will continuously blame the past for your predicament. A vagabond spirit can be seen, always bringing a restlessness and a feeling of hopelessness and “unwantedness” along

As a mother City, the enemy recognizes her mandate and redemptive purpose in a nation, and therefore sends all his demonic powers to counter her true potential. He fears the rise of such a city, as she will give birth to the revival of God's best for that nation. He will even go as far as legislate previously unacceptable lifestyles from her midst to further delay his eviction. Under these measures, he then creates a culture of acceptance to prevent this city from giving birth to true champions by physically allowing abortions to be an

option. He floods the city with unnatural, ungodly relationships and clothe the city with international fame and status as a forerunner in gay and lesbian lifestyles. Such relationships make humanity barren and fruitless and steal the next generation from being born! He chooses his cities very cunningly and with great precision and then clothes it with the opposite of God's mandate!

This is exactly what God showed me during my visit to the Mother City of Cape Town! But He did not show it to me to ponder on the negative and expose it, as we all know what has been happening in Cape Town. When God shows up, He shows up for action! He shows up to bring a radical change and to change the status quo.

Cape Town, God wants to change the following:

- Stop the high rate of abortions, abandoned children, child abuse, substance abuse and immoral relationships.
- He wants to give all races tolerance for one another, and identity to those being branded as "in between".
- He wants to raise champions from your midst to lead our nation, continent and the nations to Christ!
- He wants to make you a model of His kingdom and begin to release fresh, new and innovative measures and methods into your midst to reach the world with His Gospel.
- Your mountain, the symbol of a table is His Prophetic sign and symbol of successful deliberations, governance, sustenance, provision and unity, a place of interaction in a comfortable environment. It is a sign of peace and rest amidst your enemies.

The key to our City and every other City of the World:

We read in verse 16 of 2nd Samauel chapter 20, of a wise woman who rose to the occasion and saved an entire City from destruction:

"Then a wise woman cried out of the city, Hear, hear! Please say to Joab, Come near here so that I may speak with you."

A wise woman is the prophetic image of the Bride of the Lord Jesus Christ, being alert, watchful, in tune with the spiritual surroundings and constantly available to assist and support the City with Godly advice. She has a reputation of being accurate, considerate, appropriate, applicable, actively involved, and sincere about the role she has to play in the safety and security and well-being of the inhabitants of the entire

City. She is considered the guardian of the City, without political affiliations, no hidden, selfish agendas and personal preferences. The true image of a City Church, with her eyes on the Lord Jesus Christ and His great Commission.

The writer of this passage, inspired by the Holy Spirit, calls this woman wise. To be addressed as such by the Spirit of wisdom, means she had the following qualities, evidently earned from her encounters in real-life situations:

- To be skilful, especially in practical ways. Your actions bring fruitful changes.
- To be skilful, in administrative ways. Applying yourself, your resources and all you have available in the right places, with great wisdom to achieve the greatest result.
- To be shrewd, crafty, cunning and subtle. This means to apply you in such a way that you reach across boundaries, affect all societies, by being yeast, light and salt. Your gift makes the way, not your association, as association creates exclusivity, while gifts and grace brings opportunities. Become less “Christian” as we have known Christianity according to “Churchianity” and just become more like Christ!
- To be innovative, intelligent, wise, learned, and artful, become creative.
- To be relevant, applicable, timeous and measureable in your actions and activities. Earn your right to be heard! Become known for your solutions, not your sermons!

What an awesome image of the Body of Christ in real-life situations where communities are faced with a multitude of issues, truly becoming the mountain to which nations will come...

This wise woman was alert to the change in her City, as she was familiar with its spiritual atmosphere. She was in tune with God’s expectations for the City and understood her mandate as a watch keeper, a gatekeeper, a custodian, a guardian over the area. She did not have to fast and pray for a solution, or have an all-night prayer meeting, as her measure was God’s will for that City. As the rebel entered, she became alert through her warning system, the standard of God, also known as the Holy Spirit. She did not negotiate with the rebel; she approached the answer to the threat, God’s desire for her City. She did not have to check with God if the rebel was unwelcome, all she did, was to confirm that God’s standard was to be applied and then moved into action.

A timeous word from the Lord to Cape Town:

“Cape Town, mother of the cities of South Africa, your time has come to rise up and take your rightful place. Your time has come to stand up and take your future away from the enemy. For too long have you tolerated the rebels of destruction to dwell within your walls, for too long have you accepted the direction of the ones seeking

your destruction. Now your time has come for shaking off the garment of foreign kings and priests shake off the coverings of slumber and arise as the guardian of the coming season of overflowing abundance to reach into the north and overturn the armies of the tradesman, trading with your women and children in far off places. Shake off, take off, rip off the garments sold to you by the merchants of doom, the merchants of restlessness and distress. He has entered your palaces of wisdom, he has walked freely in your places of rest, he has controlled your wine and oil and even disrupted the coming in and the going out of your supplies by land and sea, by heaven and earth. Your children he made to dance in the daytime, to lure them away into the night, to be his sacrifice, to be his slaves, to be his trophy dripping with blood and to display his power over you. His music soothed your sorrows, made you forget who you are in the night, he changed your day into night and let you seek for slumber, let you seek for slumber to escape the brightness of the day. With him he brought all his friends, he brought all his friends and promised them space and room to practise their trade. He offered fame and fortune, to his friends, made them to be known in places far and wide. He clothed your city, covered her beauty and shared with her his royal robes of filth. She staggered, reaching out for righteousness, but found none. She cried for truth, but got no answer, she hoped for deliverance and wept at night, covered her head in shame with the clouds from above, and at the break of day, she arose with new hope, expecting her table to be graced with true sons of wisdom, sons brought about by the travail of a wise mother. Sons kept from the music of the tradesmen, kept from the food of the kings and priests, spared by the vision of a mother and clothed in righteousness.

From the table of the Most High they have been fed, from His presence they are clothed, from their lips the trumpet is sound, arise mother of all cities, your time has come to take the lead, to break up the fallow ground, to uproot kingdoms, overthrow strongholds, break open prison doors, setting the captives free. A birth took place, o come all you who seek righteousness, all you who cherish holiness, o come you who weep between the porch and the altar. Your weeping will now bring a reward, your crying will be repaid, and so will your waiting bring in the harvest.

And Jehovah shall utter His voice before His army; for His camp is very great; for strong is He who does His Word. For the day of Jehovah is great and very terrible; and who can stand it?

Yet even now, says Jehovah, turn to Me with all your heart, and with fasting, and with weeping, and with mourning.

Yes, tear your heart and not your robes, and turn to Jehovah your God: for He is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and He pities because of the evil.

Who knows if He will turn and have pity and leave a blessing behind Him, a food offering and a drink offering to Jehovah your God?

Blow a trumpet in Zion, sanctify a fast, call a solemn gathering.

Gather the people, sanctify the congregation, gather the elders, gather the children and those who suck the breasts. Let the bridegroom go forth out of his chamber, and the bride out of her room.

Let the priests, the ministers of Jehovah, weep between the porch and the altar, and let them say, Have pity on Your people, O Jehovah, and give not Your inheritance to shame, for a proverb among those of the nations. Why should they say among the people, Where is their God? Then Jehovah will be jealous for His land and pity His people.

Yes, Jehovah will answer and say to His people, Behold, I will send you grain, and wine, and oil, and you shall be satisfied with it. And I will no more make you a curse among the nations.

But I will remove the northern army far from you, and will drive him into a barren and deserted land, with his face toward the eastern sea and his rear toward the western sea. And his stench shall come up, and his ill odor shall come up, because he was doing great things. Fear not, O land; be glad and rejoice. For Jehovah will do great things.

Conclusion:

Please note that is not by far meant to be a final, conclusive and exhaustive word, but only an opening as I heard it from the Lord. It is only the beginning of greater things the Lord will begin to reveal to the City of Cape Town. God woke me each morning long before the sun rose with great excitement filling the atmosphere and my surroundings. Another significant prophetic symbol was the duration of my visit, which came to 8 days. The number 8 speaks of new beginnings. David was the eighth son of Jesse and the prophet Amos prophesied that the tabernacle of David would be restored...

Although God opened this word to me while I was in the Mother City of Cape Town, it is not meant to be only for Cape Town, as every City, town and community can identify with numerous social problems that can be traced back to spiritual rebels, or forces, who moved into the area, and have now become part of the culture and day-to-day living. It is also not aimed as criticism at the Mother City of Cape Town, but as a prophetic utterance from God's heart to inform us of His intentions to release greater grace and accurate gifting into the City as He brings the City Church in alignment with His purposes for the nations. It is time the eyes of the Lord, who runs back and forth throughout all the earth, seeking for someone with a loyal heart, returns as our true vision. We must once again look at one another, and the seasons, through the eyes of the Spirit and not be impressed by natural appearances. We intend to pay large accolades for stale bread, set up outrages stages for yesterday’s anointing, and channel great proportions of our resources into stagnated rivers. Each one of us, are known by our fruits, the way we live, determines the seed we carry along with us and the seed we carry, determines the coming harvest. Long after we are gone, those who remain behind, live from the seed we brought.

David, God’s choice, took over from Saul, who was actually man’s choice whom God allowed to reign for a season, until David was ready to be revealed. The next season is always born in the existing season, as tomorrow’s season needs today’s season to mature...

Always remember that God determines the times and seasons, He selects the vessels and deposits the grace, so we are mere carriers of His Grace, His containers filled with all that belongs to Him. So to Him all the glory, honour and grace. No man can boast outside Christ, and so I declare that I am nothing without Christ and only something because of Christ in me. Hear Him, see Him, believe Him, honour Him, and glorify Him and Him alone!
