Introduction

Many years ago my wife Jacqueline and I, made a covenant with God based on the portion of scripture recorded in the Gospels of Matthew and Luke, where Jesus gave His disciples strict instructions not to be concerned or worried about the ordinary things in life, such as food, clothing and other material possessions. *“But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added to you”*, He told them, knowing how important this would be in the assignment He had for them, and those who would join His mission in generations to come.

At the time we made this covenant with God, we were literally at a very low point in our lives, as scheme upon scheme came crashing down on us. After we both left fulltime employment in the world to follow God’s call into the ministry, we thought we needed to help God out in the financial department by setting up some kind of a business to support us. After numerous attempts to establish several businesses, and over a painful period of three years, the reality suddenly struck us: “We are about to loose everything!” Not only did we loose both our cars, our house was about to be sold at an auction and we had no way to prevent this from happening! I was advised by other Christians to give up on the idea that God had called me into fulltime ministry and find myself some kind of employment in the marketplace. Jacqueline and I spent most of our days desperately seeking ways and means to establish some kind of income generating venture, but without any success! One thing I must say, we never gave up trying! Even our family members knew that if the one idea failed, we would be up and running with the next in no time! I became an expert in the design and printing of business cards as I had this strange belief that my name on a business card gave me some credibility, and a false sense of security that I am important and valuable! This only lasted until after my first appointment where I tried to turn my dream into reality and were sent home with the very familiar phrase: “Thank you so much for contacting us, we’ll be in touch”. And so, over a period of three years I saw the inside of many different offices, from that of Ceo’s of the private sector to even that of very high-ranking government officials.

Dreams...God’s language

During October 2000, I had a dream that changed my life completely and cured me from running around trying to frantically establish some kind of business. In this dream, God spoke to me and clearly told me to stop any attempts to take care of myself in the manner I was used to, and to begin to trust Him unconditionally from that moment. He told me that He would take care of my family, as He needed me to focus entirely on His plans for the earth and for mankind. God gave me the mentioned portion of Scripture and told me He would like us to allow Him to model the Scripture through our lives. He was looking for someone through whom He could show others what happens if you seek His Kingdom and His

righteousness above all, and let Him take care of the rest. When I shared this with Jacqueline, we both decided to covenant with God in this regard. Although our house was so far in arrears that it was set to be sold on the 7th of December 2000 at a public auction, we decided to believe God for the impossible! Needless to say, our house was never sold on that day or any other day for that matter, and we are still living in it with our two beautiful children, Joshua and Monique. This all happened almost 10 years ago and since we made the covenant with God, our lives have become one long, continuous journey of moving from faith to faith! God began to bless us in ways we never thought possible. He gradually began to turn our circumstances as we allowed Him more and more freedom to do as He pleased. Little did we know that God's ultimate plan with us was to turn us from worriers, into warriors! Most of us serve God in a way that brings no credit or any benefit to Him and His kingdom whatsoever. We learnt that every encounter with God is meant to create a result, which is mutually beneficial to both parties. Each time we are faced with a test, it is not only the party who is tested that's supposed to learn from it, but all who are involved, affected or even observing. Circumstances and incidences are great opportunities for growth towards maturity and so are conflict situations a perfect incubator to bring forth new levels of victory over previous defeats.

Time for renovations

You must remember that our lives are likened to a building site where great renovations are constantly taking place. There were times when we built for many years without the presence of the building inspector to check to which specifications we were building. When we eventually are connected to the Master Builder, the Designer and Originator of our lives, God Himself, through Jesus Christ our Saviour, most of our sites are a total disgrace and may even need more than just a revamp! In fact, most of our own efforts need to be completely demolished when the Holy Spirit, our building inspector, steps on site! It is for this very reason that most young Christians, not young in age, but young in their relationship with God, feel like giving up their newfound faith, when this process of reconstruction begins. All hell seems to break loose around them as the enemy, our own flesh and our stubborn nature go into a battle to prevent the Holy Spirit from re-erecting a work of divine art which will bring eternal value and glory to our once, fruitless, selfish lives. That is why the Bible states the following in Ephesians chapter 2 verse 10:

“For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to good works, which God has before ordained that we should walk in them.”

Note that we have been designed according to the specifications of heaven and released onto the earth to be exactly the work of art He created. Our very presence in any given situation is proof that everything is about to change and be conformed to what God has in mind for us!

As Jacqueline and I made our choice to allow God to shape us until we become living testimony of Matthew chapter 6 verse 33, seeking first His

Kingdom and His righteousness, and all the other things will be added unto us, a tremendous shaking took place! Everything we thought we knew about God and Christianity suddenly came under the search light of the building inspector. Structures in which we placed our faith and based our trust upon, were unceremoniously removed, people we used to rely on, suddenly turned their backs on us, systems we used to support our needs began to miserably fail us. For a very long time everything seemed to be working against us, causing great confusion, discomfort and indescribable fear. We felt abandoned, rejected and useless. It was as if we were positioned in the middle of a building site, which was earmarked for complete destruction, and we watched in horror as everything we had built over the years, was torn down. At times we would panic and would hastily try and put measures in place to keep it from coming crashing down, only to realize we were no longer in control! Most of our family and friends looked at us as if we had turned our backs on God and were being sorted out. To them, in their opinion, it was evident that God had a serious problem with us and that we had been moved out of the way by Him. And we could not but agree with them as our plans, dreams, hopes and desires came tumbling down in one massive cloud of dust! As our vision was adjusted to the dim light caused by all the dust and commotion going on around us, we began to notice a very steady, sure, comforting Person in the midst of all the confusion. In His hand, He held a clipboard and a plumb line, and as He continued to refer to the documents on the clipboard, He would apply His plumb line to the existing structures, only to shake His head in disapproval. As he shook His head, a great trembling would occur, bringing that which He measured, tumbling down! God's plan began to unfold before our eyes – He was in the process of removing old mindsets based on religious structures. Part of the process was to rid us of all second hand building material He found in our lives. Let me explain:

Building with second hand material

For most of us it is very easy to confess our faith in God when we have everything we need around us to support us. Not that it is wrong to proclaim our faith and trust in God at the end of the month when we receive our paychecks, but so many of us so easily give advice to others to trust God when there is no immediate solution for their predicament. I used to proclaim and confess my unwavering faith in God so boldly when I was in the fulltime employ of an organization, which paid me a steady and fixed salary at the end of each month. My advice to people in distress would always be to trust God, as He would never be too late to rescue us in times of need. Up until that point, I never really had to trust God for my salary as I was in a good, secure position, which paid well. During all these years of my advertising my allegiance to God, I sounded like a man of faith; I made the right noises at the right time and always knew how to encourage others when needed. To an outsider, I was the model of faith in God, no matter what I had to face! Little did they know, and even less so did I know myself, that all my confessions were based on what I read in the Word and what other people would say in similar situations to those under financial pressure. I was handing out "hearsay" advice, meaning whatever I heard about God from others, I repeated, with the audacity to pretend it was the way I lived! I think many of us live this way until our site is due for an inspection! During this inspection

all our confessions are put to the test to see how secure it has been built and if it could endure all kind of storms.

Apart from my salvation, and being filled with the Holy Spirit, I had no real encounters with God other than sporadic, superficial moments I allowed Him to have with me, when I needed something from Him. Every time I had contact with God, it was on my terms and with only my needs in mind. Salvation was something that would benefit me in the far distant future and being filled with the Holy Spirit was reserved for times on Sundays during Church services. I was stuck in the same lifestyle I lived before salvation, as I thought Jesus was my ticket to heaven. With this kind of mindset firmly nestled in the centre of all I did, I would pretend to be on God's side of the line. To put in bluntly, I was so religious I made the devil jealous, as he is the king of religion and fake living is his speciality, and I gave him a run for his money! And so I built an entire "relationship" with God with second hand information, and other people's confessions.

This is exactly where God began His process with us 10 years ago, after a period of 3 years during which we tried to build a future for ourselves, using "second hand material". We both resigned our fulltime employment to be available for God to use us in a mighty way. Jacqueline was first to take the "step of faith", as we all like to call such a move, during 1997 and I boldly followed in 1998. We were sure that we had enough faith to impress God in order for Him to join us in whatever endeavor we would decide to take on! I mean that I was known for my walk with God and people often came to me for prayer and encouragement in the past. How difficult could it be, this "faith walk" we so often spoke about to others in need! Suddenly we no longer had a fixed income; in fact, we had no income whatsoever. This is when we stepped out of the boat and began to frantically put together the one business plan after the other. I would travel from one meeting to the next, day after day, week after week, month after month. As the petrol in my vehicle's tank would cause the needle to move closer to the dreadful "e" mark, so did my faith, and my trust in God followed suit. Faith told me "e" on the dash stands for "enough", but my lack of real faith told me it represented "eish!" in my life.

Pleasing God or squeezing God?

We eventually had to give up both our cars, our telephone lines were cut and I was forced to slow down rather drastically in running around. After 10 years of really walking with God, trusting Him unconditionally and knowing Him first hand, we are pleased to say most of the rubble has been removed from our previous structures. On the same site where so much pulling down took place, the sign of a brand new foundation is beginning to show! It has taken us so long to stop interfering with His plans that most of the demolishing had to take place under great protest. In the beginning, we would take God on over every action He planned on our site, drawing Him into lengthy boardroom discussions, causing weeks, or perhaps even months of delays in the process. We could not understand why He just would not put His stamp of approval on what *we* had in mind. We had such noble and biblical plans for the future that we were convinced even God would be blessed by our involvement! Our religious point of view of God taught us that God had no

option but to support us, and if He turned us down, He would suffer a great loss that would take Him generations to recover from! We were under the impression that being saved gave God some access to our busy schedules and brilliant plans. We were the initiators of our schemes and if we quoted enough scriptures went to church fairly often and remembered to pray when in need, God would have been delighted to hear us mention Him as our partner in business. All we required of Him was to be in the vicinity, preferably out of sight in the background, in case we needed a miracle that would make us look good!

From Worriers to Warriors...

In Matthew 6 verse 33, Jesus makes it very clear to us that we have to realign our perspective of life in general as Christians. In the world, it is the norm to put all our efforts into establishing ourselves according to our physical and material needs. Unsaved people spend most, if not all their energy, time, talents and resources on fulfilling their carnal appetites as the finding of these things bring security and stability in life. And so Jesus said the most important aspect of life, is placed way down on the list of priorities. Because of this, most of us discover that we have built along the wrong lines and totally incorrectly, when we come to salvation. We have been chasing the wrong things in life and wasted so much of our precious talents on unimportant projects. A true, real, intimate relationship with God as our only source is the only place from where we should live. He is the beginning and the end of all. We should teach our children to seek God with everything they have and to leave everything else up to Him. We fail so miserably if we start to worry about our children's future the moment they are born. We begin to dream dreams on their behalf and whatever we teach them is based on our fears, failures and our disappointments gathered in our own experiences. We drill it into them to get a good education, qualify themselves in a career offering security and wealth. Not that this is completely wrong, but our emphasis should rather be on their relationship with God than their positioning on the earth towards their future.

In the Contemporary English version of the Bible the word "worry" is used to describe Jesus' conversation with His disciples. "Can worry make your life longer?" He asked them. Somebody who is known for his or her ability to worry about life – It is interesting to note the description of the word "worry" according to the English Thesaurus:

It is defined as anxiety and trouble, and is synonymous with words such as:

Anguish, annoyance, apprehension, bad news, care, concern, disquiet, distress, disturbance, doubt, fear, problem, trial, torment, torture, uncertainty, uneasiness, woe and worryment.

It is obvious that the above words all describe an environment not conducive to spiritual growth and advancement.

Another very interesting word derived from the word worry, is the word “worrier” and according to the English Thesaurus is described as follows:

Main entry: critic

Definition: faultfinder, detractor (nonbeliever, disbeliever, doubter, unbeliever)

Synonyms: attacker, backseat driver, belittler, blamer, complainant, complainer, defamer, disapprover, disputer, doubter, maligner, mud-slinger, nagger, nit-picker, quibbler, reviler, scolder, sidewalk superintendent, slanderer, vilifier, worrier, zapper.

Imagine being seen by God as someone who constantly finds fault with His methods and plans towards our lives. Whatever He says, we question and continuously doubt His motives towards us! We are forever working in the opposite direction of His actions and cause Him great trouble in His endeavors to release the fullness of life upon us.

For or against God?

God has to literally fight us off each time He wants to move us to a better place. It is like going in for an operation, signing the consent documents, granting the doctor permission to perform the procedure, and then refuse to be put under anesthetic because you want to “oversee” the process and instruct the specialist! I do not think any of us will allow the surgeon to come near us with that scalpel, if we were awake! Yet we do the same to God, we sign the consent documents at salvation for Him to give us life and life more abundantly. We then agree with His specialist opinion on the reconstruction we need to have this kind of life, and we surrender ourselves completely into His capable hands and then we become specialists ourselves! Suddenly we know better than Him, we know more than Him and we know a shorter process than Him to produce even better results than Him!

I believe “worry” is perhaps the single most disqualifying factor, causing the vast majority of us for not walking in complete authority on the earth. It is perhaps the reason why God’s children are living in bondage and are not used by God to set the captives free. The Bible says that without faith, it is impossible to please God and the opposite of faith is of course unbelief. A Christian who constantly worries about general things, which according to Jesus, requires no faith at all to have access to and enjoy, is equivalent to the heathens. You see Jesus wanted us to understand that it is not our faith that entitles us to material provision, but the depth and genuineness of our relationship towards God.

The very foundation of being powerfully used by God lies in our priorities. Putting Him first and above anything else in our lives creates a platform from which He can launch Himself into our future. From this platform, He can reach others through us in a way no one can begin to imagine. He wants to raise warriors who can battle the forces of darkness on His behalf. There are millions of people on planet earth, locked up in spiritual, emotional and physical prisons, created and erected by themselves through simply having

their priorities all mixed up. More so is my concern with God's own children, who are in no better state than those in the world for the very same reason: upside down priorities! Christianity has been watered down to become just another religion out of thousands of others to choose from. The only difference between us and those in the world is which block we tick on the census form under the heading "religion".

This is our season to rise up and be counted by God as a valuable member of His army. Nations lie in captivity while great assignments have been put on hold in heaven due to a lack of suitable vessels! As Biblical prophecy after prophecy are being fulfilled almost on a daily basis in our generation, the time has arrived for the Church to do some soul searching and begin to measure herself according to the description found of her in God's Word.

God wants us to be warriors, joined together with Him in His mission to bring all of mankind into a relationship with Him through His Son Jesus Christ. He wants us to convey the victory He tasted on Calvary to the four corners of the earth, and impact every nation with the results of the battle of the cross. Two thousand years ago, He already defeated the enemy, broke his power, removed his authority, disarmed him and made a public spectacle of him for all to see. All we have to do is to enlist in His army and gather the spoils. We are in the clean-up division, following in the footsteps of our Commanding Officer to enforce the victory He purchased with His own life.

The word "warrior" is described as follows in the English Thesaurus:

Definition: person who fights in a battle

*"Fight the good fight of faith. Lay hold on eternal life, to which you are also called and have professed a good profession before many witnesses."
(1 Tim 6:12)*

*"Therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ.
No one who wars tangles with the affairs of this life, that he may please him who chose him to be a soldier."
(2 Tim 2:3 - 4)*

*"For the weapons of our warfare are not fleshly, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strongholds,"
(2 Cor 10:4)*

Words synonymous to warrior are listed as:

Battler, champion, combatant, conscript (recruit), enlisted person, fighter, fighting person, hero, serviceperson, trooper.

Definition of a champion:

Defeater in competition, pre-eminent supporter

The word “champion” is synonymous to the following:

Advocate, ally (something united with another, especially by treaty), backer, challenger, conqueror, defender, endorser, exponent, expounder, guardian, hero, heroine, medallist, patron, proponent, protector, supporter, sympathizer, upholder, victor, vindicator, warrior, winner.

The more I look at these definitions and synonyms of the words worrier and warrior, the more I see the two opposite camps currently represented in Christianity. Although the worriers are saved, they are of no significant value to God and His purposes down here on earth. They live from day to day, from one calamity to the next, barely making it through life. All they want to do is live, then die, and go to heaven! To them deliverance from their circumstances and the promise of abundant life is something they will enjoy in heaven. Due to their point of view, God cannot and will not use them for any great mission, as they hardly have enough faith to pull them through to the end.

It is finished!

Then on the other side, we find the warriors! Ordinary men and women who discovered why Jesus the Christ really came to the earth. To them Calvary was not just the place where Jesus died alone, but He died for all of us, once and for all. When He said, “it is finished”, He did not only declare to His Father that He completed His mission and obligation towards Him as a righteous, holy God, He also made a declaration in the very face of every demonic entity! From his bleeding, bruised lips, He announced the new season for mankind on the earth! With that declaration, He set the stage for every battle to be fought in His Name, in the coming generations. He settled the score once and forever, whoever will trust in Him will be more than conquerors each time they encounter demonic opposition. It was a done deal for all eternity and for generations to come, to enjoy.

I believe after Jesus breathed His last, the devil must have thought it was over and done with Jesus, because Jesus said so Himself. He most probably thought those were the words of a dying man, announcing the end of his life, as death was about to swallow him and end his legacy here on earth. No one can blame him for not realising what was really happening at that very moment in time! This was totally new to him, never in his entire existence had he experienced anything that was about to follow Jesus’ last words on the cross. In going to the cross willingly and laying down His life wilfully, His obedience towards the Father settled the account mankind had outstanding with God. God was satisfied, the only sacrifice for sin, was made. The lamb without blemish had shed His blood, exactly according to the standards, requirements and specifications of the Almighty, Holy God. So this part was done and through His obedience to the Father, Jesus was now ready for the next part of His assignment: Defeat the devil and all his demons, take the keys of hell and death away from him, disarm him and his principalities and then to rise again on the third day, fulfilling every prophecy concerning Him. When Jesus died, He died as the last Adam ever to walk on the earth. Those who chose Him as their Lord and Saviour have been rid of the sins and nature

of Adam. When He rose from the dead, He rose as the second man, indicating a brand new season for all who have died with Him, were buried with Him in baptism and have now risen with Him in His image and likeness.

The ultimate purpose in life – becoming champions!

When we join ourselves to Jesus, we are known as recruits, fresh and ready to be trained. Gradually we are changed into soldiers, ready to be sent out onto the battlefield. The ultimate purpose for us being trained as soldiers is to send us out into numerous battles, winning each and every time. The more we go into battle, the more skilful we become. With the victories comes a maturity until God refers to us as His warriors! Warriors have a reputation of being unstoppable; they are known for their great exploits and eventually become known as champions. In the days of the Bible, a champion was sent out to fight on behalf of the entire army as Goliath against young David. The whole nation's future was determined by the success of their champion.

“And a champion named Goliath came out of the Philistines camp; he was from Gath. His height was six cubits and a span.” (1 Sam 17:4)

Note how the Bible refers to Goliath as a “champion”. Look at the function of such a champion in the following verses:

“And he stood and cried to the armies of Israel, and said to them, why have you come out to set your battle in order? Am I not a Philistine, and are you not servants to Saul? Choose a man for you, and let him come down to me.

If he is able to fight with me and kill me, then we will be your slaves. But if I prevail against him and kill him, then you shall be our slaves and serve us.” (1 Sam 17:8 – 9)

I do not think I have to remind you that our champion, the One chosen by God to fight the battle at Calvary on behalf of all mankind, won so convincingly, and that this victory has settled the score for eternity. Jesus stepped out of the battle as ultimate victor and through Him; we are no longer slaves to the devil. When Goliath defied the armies of the living God that day, it was a prophetic challenge indicating towards the coming of the Lord Jesus Christ and Golgotha. He boldly challenged the Israelites “to choose a man for you, and let him come down to me”, thinking he would easily defeat whomever Israel would choose. When young David, the shepherd boy came to the battlefield to bring his brothers something to eat, he heard the commotion and immediately the real reason why he was created rose up within him! You see David was anointed, not so long before this encounter, to be the next king of Israel. Kings are meant to ensure the safety and well-being of their subjects. They are put into power for their ability to provide protection, comfort, safety, prosperity and advancement to the nation. At this point in time, Saul was the reigning king in Israel and although he was in charge on the battlefield when David arrived, he was powerless against the threats of the Philistines. Saul had already been disqualified by God as king, for his disobedience and lack of trusting God, which we read about in 1 Samuel chapter 15. Israel's king was supposed to be the voice and guidance of God Himself to the nation.

We are that “Chosen man...”

Along came young David, and again as a prophetic symbol and indication of the coming of the Lord Jesus Christ to mankind in trouble. There is so much prophetic depth and insight in these scriptures, if you read it through the guidance of the Holy Spirit! It is also a pointing to the birth of the Church of Jesus, the corporate man, the body of Jesus that would rise from the dead with Jesus to continue to be a reminder to the devil of his defeat at Calvary! Each time the devil looks at the Church in unity, he is reminded of that day when Jesus went to the cross, completely joined in obedience to His Father. Churches operating in unity scare the living daylights out of him!

You and I, as the Body of Christ on the earth, are that “man” who has been anointed to step forward onto the battlefield, which is raging over individuals, cities, nations, continents and generations! When David arrived on the scene, Saul’s season had already come to an end in heaven. Although his kingship had expired in heaven, it had not yet manifested on the earth, as God was still busy preparing the next king of His choice. We must remember that everything originates in heaven and long before it is revealed on the earth, God establishes it in His realm. The prophets who operate in unison with God will be aware of these changes that have taken place in heaven way before anyone else and it is therefore the function of these prophets to prepare the earth for that, which is coming in the new season. Many people are so out of tune with heaven and the patterns of heaven that they are unaware of the changes that have taken place in the Spirit and continue to operate outside heaven’s mandate for their lives. This is what happened to Saul. In the natural, earthly realm he was still recognized, and operated as king, although heaven had already withdrawn its support. That is why he had no authority to take on the Philistines in battle. It is so important for us to regularly check if heaven is still backing us up, before we move on or take on any assignment. David was living in such an intimate relationship with God that he knew exactly when he had offended heaven and needed to repent, as we read in Psalm 51, when he committed adultery at a later stage in his life.

To come back to David’s breaking onto the scene in his first public display as God’s anointed, we further read in 1 Samuel chapter 17 and verses 45 and 46 how he prophesied his victory over the giant as he stepped forward to meet him. As David conquered Goliath as God’s chosen and anointed vessel, he performed another prophetic act by cutting off the giant’s head and taking it to Jerusalem with him as we read in verses 51 to 54 of the same chapter. I believe this is an indication of the final battle between two champions, which would take place in years to come, and a repeat of what God said to the serpent in the garden of Eden after he deceived Adam and Eve:

*“And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her Seed; He will bruise your head, and you shall bruise His heel.”
(Gen 3:15)*

Let us remind ourselves of the name of the place where Jesus was crucified:

“And bearing His cross, He went out to a place called, The Place of a Skull (which is called in the Hebrew, Golgotha) where they crucified Him, and two others with Him, one on either side, and Jesus in the middle.” (John 19:17 – 18)

Could this perhaps be the reason why David took the head of the giant, Goliath to Jerusalem? Did David, a man so close to God, that God referred to him as “a man after My own heart”, see into the future and pave the way in the spirit realm for the greatest battle ever to be fought over the most prized possession and position at stake?

Hear the call from heaven, this is the season!

Let us enrol in His army, and be changed from WORRIERS into WARRIORS. First, we need to become recruits by reporting for duty, then be trained to become soldiers, as we are sent into small battles, let us stand firm and win the victory in places we used to run from before. Let us conquer our own circumstances to show Him we are ready to become warriors, representing His Kingdom. As we progress as warriors, let us show the skills and nature of champions so that we can be used by Him to determine the outcome of certain battles, which is raging over entire cities and nations!

Commit yourself to Him and His purpose for your life right now by praying the following prayer...

“Our Father in heaven,

Today I acknowledge that I am aware of so much more You have in store for me. You created me to be more than a conqueror and therefore I choose to receive Jesus Christ, Your Son, as my Saviour and to submit to Him as my Lord.

I declare that I receive eternal life through the sacrifice of the Lord Jesus Christ, who died for me personally on the cross of Calvary. Being born-again now makes me aware that something Awesome belongs to me, even this very day, while I am still living on the earth. Lead me to the correct place where I can be submitted to accurate teachings that proceeds from Your mouth for me as a unique, specially created vessel. I want to be a champion for Christ, to be used by You to bring nations into Your Kingdom! Break me free from any manmade structures, where manipulation and selfish ambitions exists.
